



Northwest Fuchsia Society Endowment Scholarship

The Northwest Fuchsia Society was established to further the interest and promote the study of Fuchsias. The Fuchsia is an ornamental flower that is colored in shades of red, blue, purple, pink, orange, as well as white. The color fuchsia, a vivid, reddish-purple, was named for the brilliant color of the Fuchsia flower. Nearly all members of the species are native to Central and South America. The Society encourages the propagation and cross-fertilization of various species. The fuchsia is a common flower used in urban horticulture and the members of the fuchsia society wish to educate people to the aesthetic value and ornamental use of the flower as landscape shrub and pollinator plant.

The Northwest Fuchsia Society created a scholarship fund in 1989 to promote continued education in the field of horticulture. The Northwest Fuchsia Society Endowment Scholarship for horticulture studies provides a way to assist deserving students the opportunity to continue their education in the study of horticulture. ELIGIBILITY/QUALIFICATIONS

1. Applicants must be studying or planning to study in the area of horticulture in an accredited technical/vocational school, community college, or a four year college/university.
Horticulture, (including Floriculture, Landscape & Post-harvest physiology) will also include Botany and Ecology.
2. The applications must include biographical data, transcript, statements, and a letter of recommendation.
3. Applicants must be residents of the Pacific Northwest.
4. The criteria for the scholarship are: academics; community involvement; work experience; school financial need; and membership in a fuchsia club (optional).
5. Applications for the scholarship are available in the financial aid office of the institutions of post-high school education.

4. The amount of the scholarship will be up to \$2,500.00 dependent on our annual ROI and will be mailed, with an award letter, directly to the financial aid office stated in the application and used for for tuition and books.
